CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

Entering his 10th NLL season and second with the expansion-era Knighthawks ... Scored the game-winning goal in his return to the lineup in the 19-18 win at Georgia on 3/12/23 after missing the previous seven games due to injury ... ACQUIRED

Signed a three-year contract with the Rochester Knighthawks on August 11, 2022. Acquired by Rochester along with goaltender Riley Hutchcraft and the first overall pick in the 2022 NLL Entry Draft from the Las Vegas Desert Dogs during the 2022 Expansion Draft.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

Enters his fourth season in the NLL and first with the expansion-era Knighthawks ... Became the fifth player this season and the first player in franchise history to record 100 points in a season following his third 10-point effort (2+8) of the season in the 14-12 loss to Albany on 4/8/23 ...
