#### ACQUIRED

Signed a two-year deal with the Rochester Knighthawks on August 5, 2021. Re-signed a one-year deal with the Knighthawks on July 16, 2024.

#### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

Entering his 12th NLL season and fourth with the expansion-era Knighthawks ... Recorded his 100th career point with his second of two assists at Saskatchewan on 12/9/23 ... Named the second team captain in franchise history ... Scored the game-winning goal in his return to the lineup in the 19-18 win at Georgia on 3/12/23 after missing the previous seven games due to injury ... In his first season with Rochester in 2021-22, he paced all defensemen with 13 assists and 14 points and appeared in all 18 games ... Set the single-season franchise record for assists by a defenseman with 13 ... He was just one of five players to appear in all 18 games ... Scored his first goal as a Knighthawk and added an assist against Toronto on 4/09/22 ... Recorded his first two points as a Knighthawk with a pair of assists against Georgia on 1/21 ... Made his Knighthawks debut at New York on 12/04 ... Acquired by the Georgia Swarm on July 6, 2020, but was unable to appear in a game following the cancellation of the 2020-21 NLL season due to the COVID-19 pandemic ... He spent nine seasons with the Colorado Mammoth, during which he compiled 75 points (15+60), 492 loose ball recoveries and 139 caused turnovers in 128 career games ... Posted his best season during the 2014-15 campaign when he scored one goal and posted career-highs in assists (11) and points (12) in 18 games ... Departed the Mammoth ranked second in franchise history in caused turnovers (139), fourth in face-off wins (477) and games played (128) and seventh in loose balls (492) ... A four-year captain, also added six points (1+5) and 28 loose balls in 10 postseason contests while leading the team to an unprecedented eight straight playoff appearances from 2012-2019, including a pair of trips to the Western Division Final over a three-year span ... Prior to turning pro, played his collegiate lacrosse at nearby Canisius College ... #### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

Entering his eighth season in the NLL and fifth with the expansion-era Knighthawks ... Recovered his 300th career loose ball against New York on 2/25/23 ... Surpassed the 200-point mark as part of a six-point effort against Panther City on 1/7/23 ... Established career-highs in both goals (14) and points (46) in 15 games with Rochester during the 2021-22 campaian ... ranked fifth in goals. assists and points while tying for second on the team with four power-play goals ... ## 10 | CONNOR FIELDS | 6-0 | 180 lbs. FORWARD

Shoots: Left | East Amherst, New York | October 10, 1995 | Sixth-Year Pro

#### DRAFTED

Originally selected by the San Diego Seals in the first round (10th overall) of the 2018 NLL Entry Draft.

#### ACQUIRED

Acquired by the Rochester Knighthawks along with goaltender Riley Hutchcraft and the first overall pick in the 2022 NLL Entry Draft from the Las Vegas Desert Dogs during the 2022 Expansion Draft. Signed a three-year contract with the Knighthawks on August 11, 2022. Signed a four-year contract extension with the Knighthawks through the 2028-29 season on August 29, 2024.

#### **CAREER HIGHLIGHTS**

Enters his sixth season in the NLL and third with the expansion-era Knighthawks ... Finished the 2023-24 campaign leading the Knighthawks with career-highs in goals (55) assists (64) and points (120) ... Named the team's Offensive MVP for second straight season ... Ranked second in the NLL in goals behind only New York's Jeff Teat and fourth in overall scoring while pacing all forwards in shots (267) and loose ball recoveries (158) ... Closed out the campaign as the first player since John Tavares in 2001 to record more than 115 points and 150 loose ball recoveries in the same season ... Additionally, became just the second American-born player in league history, joining Philadelphia's Joe Resetarits, a former Knighthawk in the previous organization, to reach the 100point mark in back-to-back seasons ... Saved his best performance for the final weekend of the season, totaling 16 points (11+5) while commanding a desperate Knighthawks team to a pair of must-wins, including a dominating 12-3 victory over the Philadelphia Wings in the season finale which secured the team a playoff berth for the second straight year ... Single-handedly led Rochester to its most dominant win in franchise history on 4/21/24 against Philadelphia, scoring a franchise-record seven goals, including all four in the second auarter ... Also tied a season-high with 21 shots en route to setting the NLL's single-season record for shots with 267, surpassing the original mark of 255 set by Toronto's Tom Schreiber ... Surpassed the 100-point mark for the second straight year with four points against New York on 4/6/24, joining Joe Resetarits as the only other American-born player to reach the mark in back-to-back seasons ... Named the Gatorade Canada NLL Player of the Week for Week 15 after an 11-point effort against Albany on 3/9/24 ... Tied the single-game franchise record with six goals against Albany ... Set the single-game franchise record for points (14) in the 19-15 win at Panther City on 3/3/24 ... Had a streak of 24 straight games with two or more goals spanning two seasons from 12/2/22 to 2/3/24 ... Set the single-game franchise record with 21 shots on goal at San Diego on 12/29/23 ... Recorded 11 points (4+7) at Saskatchewan on 12/9/23, earning him Gatorade Canada Player of the Week honors for Week 2 ... Had six points (4+2), including the game-winning goal, in the season-opening win over Calgary on 12/2/23 ... Named the Knighthawks Offensive MVP and a Second Team All-League selection ... Closed out his first season in Rochester leading the Knighthawks in all offensive categories, including goals (52), assists (60) and points (112) ... Finished second in the league in goals and fifth in scoring while leading all forwards with 142 loose ball recoveries ... One of just three players, joining New York's Jeff Teat and Saskatchewan's Robert Church, to have 50 goals and 50 assists, marking the first time since 2002 the NLL had three different players reach the

marks in the same season ... Reached 300 career loose ball recoveries and became just the second American-born player (Roy Colsey, 2001) in league history to score 50 goals in a season against Georgia on 4/22/23 ... Also became just the third player ever and first since Athan lannucci in 2008 to record more than 100 points and 130 loose balls in the same season ... Became the fifth player during the 2022-23 season and the first player in franchise history to record 100 points in a season following his third 10point effort (2+8) of the season in the 14-12 loss to Albany on 4/8/23 ... Factored in on 10 of Rochester's 12 goals, including his 15th straight multi-goal effort of the season, to lead the team in scoring for the 13th time in 15 games ... Also became just the third American-born player to reach the 100-point mark in a season, a feat previously accomplished by only Joe Resetarits (2018 and 2021-22) and Tom Schreiber (2022-23) ... Recorded his 100<sup>th</sup> point of the season on his 100<sup>th</sup> career goal ... Surpassed 200 career points with two goals and three assists at Las Vegas on 3/25/23 ... Set the new single-season record for assists (42) with four in the 9-8 overtime loss to Philadelphia on 3/19/23 ... Recorded his second 10-point effort of the season with five goals and five assists in the 19-18 win at Georgia on 3/12/23 ... Established a new career-high in points (76) while setting the new single-season record in goals (38) and recording his 100<sup>th</sup> career assist ... Set the franchise's new single-season scoring record (66 points) following a seven-point performance at Toronto on 3/04/23 ... #### DRAFTED

Originally selected by the previous Rochester Knighthawks franchise in the first round (9th overall) of the 2015 NLL Entry Draft.

#### ACQUIRED

Signed a three-year contract with the Rochester Knighthawks as a free agent on August 17, 2022.

#### **CAREER HIGHLIGHTS**

Enters his ninth season in the NLL and third with the expansion-era Knighthawks ... Named Chopper's Community Champ for his dedication and service to the Rochester community during the 2023-24 season ... Reached 400 career loose ball recoveries with six at Philadelphia on 4/2/23 ... Appeared in his 100<sup>th</sup> professional game against Philadelphia on 3/19/23 ... Recorded his second career hat trick – and first in the regular season – in the 11-10 overtime win over New York on 2/25/23 ... Netted his third goal of the game with 58 seconds remaining in overtime, ending the second-longest game in NLL history ... In 59 games with previous Knighthawks, Gillies recorded 50 points (22+28) and was a three-time winner of the team's community service award ... Prior to turning pro, Gillies was a four-year starter at Rochester Institute of Technology (R.I.T.) from 2012-2015 ... A mainstay on the Tigers midfield, he tallied 97 career points on 27 goals and 70 assists in 83 career games, helping the Tigers to four Liberty League titles and four trips to the NCAA Division III Tournament, including a championship game appearance in 2013 ... A 2015 USILA Honorable Mention Division III All-American selection and a second team All-Liberty League pick, Gillies is tied for 28<sup>th</sup> all-time with 219 career ground balls ... A co-captain in 2015, Gillies played in all 22 games, tallying career highs in points with 53, goals with 11 and led the team with 42 assists, the eighth-best total in school history ... He left the program as a three-time Liberty League All-Academic selection and a USILA Academic All-America selection in 2015 ...
