TONIGHT'S GAME OVERVIEW

The Rochester Knighthawks are 1-0 as they head to Segar and Sciortino Field to take on the Philadelphia Wings in Rochester's home opener. Both teams come into the contest off matinee wins to start their seasons last weekend. It will be the ninth meeting between the two NLL foes. The Knighthawks greatest win in franchise history came against the Wings on April 21, 2024, when they topped Philadelphia 12-3 for the lowest goals allowed and one of their largest margins of victory to date.

SEASON OPENER RECAP

The Knighthawks topped the San Diego Seals 15-7 to open their season last week at Pechanga Arena in California. Rylan Hartley backstopped the Knighthawks with a career day while four returning faces to the offense dominated to give the Knighthawks a season opening win. Rochester went on a five-goal run in the first half and a seven-goal run in the second half to top the Seals. The Knighthawks never trailed in the game. Connor Fields scored the game winner with 4:31 left in the first half to make it 8-2.

THE GREAT WALL OF HARTLEY

Rylan Hartley played the best game of his National Lacrosse League career last Sunday. He set a career high and broke the Knighthawks franchise record with 59 saves on 66 shots. He broke his own franchise record of 55 saves from March 4, 2023, against the Toronto Rock. His 89.4% save percentage is the second highest in an NLL game this season, only behind Warren Hill's unprecedented 96% in the 11-2 routing of Oshawa.

Hartley had 31 saves by halftime and only allowed four goals in the first half. In the second half, the Knighthawks and Hartley shutout the Seals for over 25 minutes. He even got into the offensive action. Halfway through the third quarter, after making a save, he sent an outlet to a wild open Jake Pisenó who scored Rochester's 10th goal of the game. After the game, Hartley gave credit to his goaltending partner Riley Hutchcraft.

"For me it's Hutchy on the bench," Hartley said after the win. "Hutchy and I work together and he reminds me that we're in this together and what we can do... In the room at half, we remind each other, it's not over and we have a long way to go."

THE FOUR HORSEMEN

Four returning forwards to the Knighthawks had monster games on Sunday. Thomas McConvey (4+5), Ryan Lanchbury (2+7), Ryan Smith (3+4), and Connor Fields (4+2) combined for 31 points in the win on Sunday. In the first quarter they went 2/2 on the power play and scored their first man-advantage goal after only 10 seconds of offense.

Lanchbury factored in on six of the Knighthawks first eight goals and his seven assists is the most by a player in a single game so far this season. He (162) and Smith (158) both passed Curtis Knight to move to second and third all-time in Knighthawks franchise assists.

SCOUTING THE WINGS

The Philadelphia Wings come to Rochester 1-0 after a close matchup 8-7 with the Colorado Mammoth last Saturday. Joe Resetarits and Eric Fannell each notched a pair of goals while Sam LeClair and Dalton Young were the quarterbacks combining for nine assists. Former number one overall pick Brennan O'Neill added three points on a goal and two assists. Nick Damude was the star of the show though, the netminder notched 53 saves on 60 shots on goal for an 88.3% save percentage.
