## ACQUIRED

Signed a two-year deal with the Rochester Knighthawks on August 5, 2021. Re-signed a one-year deal with the Knighthawks on July 16, 2024.

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

Entering his 13<sup>th</sup> NLL season and fifth with the Knighthawks ... Named the second team captain in franchise history.

**24-25** – Led the Knighthawks to their third consecutive playoff berth.

**23-24** - Recorded his 100<sup>th</sup> career point with his second of two assists at Saskatchewan on 12/9/23.

**22-23** - Scored the game-winning goal in his return to the lineup in the 19-18 win at Georgia on 3/12/23 after missing the previous seven games due to injury.

**21-22** - In his first season with Rochester in 2021-22, he paced all defensemen with 13 assists and 23 caused turnovers... He was just one of five players to appear in all 18 games ... Scored his first goal as a Knighthawk and added an assist against Toronto on 4/09/22 ... Recorded his first two points as a Knighthawk with a pair of assists against Georgia on 1/21 ... Made his Knighthawks debut at New York on 12/04.

**GEORGIA** - Acquired by the Georgia Swarm on July 6, 2020, but was unable to appear in a game following the cancellation of the 2020-21 NLL season due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

**COLORADO** - He spent nine seasons with the Colorado Mammoth, during which he compiled 75 points (15+60), 492 loose ball recoveries and 139 caused turnovers in 128 career games ... Departed the Mammoth ranked second in franchise history in caused turnovers (139), fourth in face-off wins (477) and games played (128) and seventh in loose balls (492) ... A four-year captain, also added six points (1+5) and 28 loose balls in 10 postseason contests while leading the team to an unprecedented eight straight playoff appearances from 2012-2019, including a pair of trips to the Western Division Final over a three-year span.

**CANISIUS** - Prior to turning pro, played his collegiate lacrosse at nearby Canisius College ... Before joining the Spiders, Dunham spent three seasons at Mount St. Mary's. As a sophomore and junior he earned First-Team All-MAAC honors. He tallied 187 ground balls and 86 caused turnovers for the Mount.



Originally selected by the San Diego Seals in the first round (10<sup>th</sup> overall) of the 2018 NLL Entry Draft.

## ACQUIRED

Acquired by the Rochester Knighthawks along with goaltender Riley Hutchcraft and the first overall pick in the 2022 NLL Entry Draft from the Las Vegas Desert Dogs during the 2022 Expansion Draft. Signed a three-year contract with the Knighthawks on August 11, 2022. Signed a four-year contract extension with the Knighthawks through the 2028-29 season on August 29, 2024.

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

Enters his seventh season in the NLL and fourth with the Knighthawks ... The reigning NLL MVP has recorded at least one point in each of his 56 career games with Rochester ...

**25-26** – Reached 300 career assists and 700 loose-ball recoveries against The Rush on 2/28/26 ... Notched 400 points as a Knighthawk with the first Rochester goal of the game on 1/10 ... Scored his 500th career point against Philadelphia on 1/9, became the seventh American-born player to reach that mark ... Fields opened this season with a six-point performance (4+2) he notched a second quarter hat trick to help the Knighthawks to a dominant 15-7 win over the San Diego Seals on 12/14/25.

**RECORDS** – His 471 career points currently rank him seventh in scoring all-time amongst American players ... ('25) Became the first American-born player in league history – and just the second overall behind Buffalo's Dhane Smith – to record three consecutive 100-point seasons ('24) First player since John Tavares in 2001 to record more than 115 points and 150 loose ball recoveries in the same season ... Additionally, became just the second American-born player in league history, joining Philadelphia's Joe Resetarits, to reach the 100-point mark in back-to-back seasons ... Set the NLL's single-season record for shots with 267, surpassing the original mark of 255 set by Toronto's Tom Schreiber.

**POTWs** – Recorded an 11-point effort (6+5) against Albany on 3/9/24 ... Recorded 11 points (4 +7) at Saskatchewan on 12/9/23 ... Recorded a team-high 10 points (4+6) in his Knighthawks debut at Georgia on 12/03/22.

**24-25** - Became just the fourth player in league history to have at least three 110-point seasons ... Scored his 200th career goal in the team's 14-13 win over San Diego on 3/29/25 ... Recorded his 400<sup>th</sup> career point as part of an eight-point effort against Colorado on 1/25/25.

**23-24** - Led the Knighthawks in goals (55) assists (64) and points (120) ... Named the team's Offensive MVP for second straight season ... Ranked second in the NLL in goals and fourth in overall scoring while pacing all forwards in shots (267) and loose ball recoveries (158) ... Saved his best performance for the final weekend of the season, totaling 16 points (11+5) in a pair of must-win games which secured the team a playoff berth for the second straight year ... Single-handedly led Rochester to its most dominant win in franchise history on 4/21/24 against Philadelphia 12-3, scoring a franchise-record seven goals, including all four in the second quarter ... Set the single-game franchise record for points (14) in the 19-15 win at Panther City on 3/3/24 ... Had a streak of 24 straight games with two or more goals spanning two seasons from 12/2/22 to 2/3/24 ... Set the single-game franchise record with 21 shots on goal at San Diego on 12/29/23.

**22-23** - Named the Knighthawks Offensive MVP and a Second Team All-League selection ... Closed out his first season in Rochester leading the Knighthawks in all offensive categories, including goals (52), assists (60) and points (112) ... Finished second in the league in goals and fifth in scoring while leading all forwards with 142 loose ball recoveries ... One of just three players, joining New York's Jeff Teat and Saskatchewan's Robert Church, to have 50 goals and 50 assists, marking the first time since 2002 the NLL had three different players reach the marks in the same season ... Reached 300 career loose ball recoveries and became just the second American-born player (Roy Colsey, 2001) in league history to score 50 goals in a season against Georgia on 4/22/23 ... Also became just the third player ever and first since Athan Iannucci in 2008 to record more than 100 points and 130 loose balls in the same season ... Became the first player in franchise history to record 100 points in a season following his third 10-point effort (2+8) of the season in the 14-12 loss to Albany on 4/8/23... Also became just the third American-born player to reach the 100-point mark in a season, a feat previously accomplished by only Joe Resetarits (2018 and 2021-22) and Tom Schreiber (2022-23) ... Recorded his 100<sup>th</sup> point of the season on his 100<sup>th</sup> career goal ... Surpassed 200 career points with two goals and three assists at Las Vegas on 3/25/23.

**BUFFALO** - Completed his third NLL season in 2021-22 with 67 points (32+35) in 18 games for the Buffalo Bandits, good for third on the team in scoring ... Also added 16 points (7+9) in six playoff contests while leading the Bandits to their second NLL Finals appearance in three years ...

**FIELD** - Helped bring the Utah Archers to back-to-back Premier Lacrosse League (PLL) championships in 2023 and 2024 ... Three-time PLL All-Star selection (2019, 2023 and 2024) ... Named a Finalist for the Eamon McEneaney Attackman of the Year Award following the 2023 season ... Two-time PLL First Team All-Pro selection (2019, 2023), including as a rookie in 2019 when he tied for second in the PLL in goals.



### DRAFTED

Originally selected by the previous Rochester Knighthawks franchise in the first round (9<sup>th</sup> overall) of the 2015 NLL Entry Draft.

### ACQUIRED

Signed a three-year contract with the Rochester Knighthawks as a free agent on August 17, 2022. Re-signed a one-year contract with the Rochester Knighthawks on October 31, 2025.

### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

Enters his 10th season in the NLL and fourth with the Knighthawks.

**25-26** - Played in his 150th career game against Las Vegas on 3/15/26 ... Scooped up his 500th career loose ball against Ottawa on 2/14/26.

**24-25** – In 17 games last season Gillies blocked 11 shots, caused 10 turnovers and scooped up 44 loose-ball recoveries. On January 4<sup>th</sup> against Georgia he had an “all over the floor” stat line, he notched a goal, an assist, six loose-ball recoveries, two caused turnovers and two blocks as the Knighthawks defeated the Swarm.

**23-24** - Named Chopper’s Community Champ for his dedication and service to the Rochester community ...

**22-23** - Reached 400 career loose ball recoveries with six at Philadelphia on 4/2/23 ... Appeared in his 100<sup>th</sup> professional game against Philadelphia on 3/19/23 ... Recorded his second career hat trick – and first in the regular season – in the 11-10 overtime win over New York on 2/25/23, Netted his third goal of the game with 58 seconds remaining in overtime, ending the second-longest game in NLL history.

**ORIGINAL KNIGHTHAWKS** - In 59 games with previous Knighthawks, Gillies recorded 50 points (22+28) and was a three-time winner of the team’s community service award ...

**RIT** - Prior to turning pro, Gillies was a four-year starter at the Rochester Institute of Technology (R.I.T.) from 2012-2015 ... A mainstay on the Tigers midfield, he tallied 97 career points on 27 goals and 70 assists in 83 career games, helping the Tigers to four Liberty League titles and four trips to the NCAA Division III Tournament, including a championship game appearance in 2013 ... As a Senior, he tallied 27 goals and set a Virginia single-season record with 25 assists. He also added 54 groundballs for the second consecutive season. Throughout his time with the Cavaliers, Williams played offensive midfield and wing on faceoffs. He had more than 40 ground balls in each of his last three seasons.
